Goodwill provides veterans with individual assessment, case management, counseling, classroom learning, work experience, job training, skill development, job placement assistance and follow-up support. We assist veterans in gaining the skills needed to be successful in all aspects of their lives.

Our services are specifically designed around the unique experiences and needs of veterans struggling with reintegration who may face multiple barriers to success. Goodwill partners with other community organizations to help provide the supports necessary for veterans to overcome individual obstacles.

We offer temporary work experience opportunities in our retail stores and through other employment partners. Our goal is to help veterans establish employment history, good work habits and transferable skills they can use to land permanent and competitive paying jobs.

We act as advocates for veterans. Our staff encourages employers to hire veterans to meet their business needs. Goodwill also works closely with the VA to help veterans access the benefits they've earned.

Goodwill of the Heartland receives funding in part through the US Department of Labor and the US Department of Veterans Affairs.
